3	Choices	1) Stop teaching, pause, and turn to student 2) Provide student with an appropriate choice or allow them to make a choice by saying "A decision please" 3) Wait for an answer 4) Finish with a thank you
4	Implied Choices	 Stop teaching. Choice made. Student to do required consequence.
5	Power Struggle	 Stop teaching and pause Square off Make eye contact Deal with any allies Gain control/ defuse situation Allow the student to save face Bring closure to the interaction with a statement
6	The Informal Agreement and Manager informed	 Outside class time. Develop an action plan with student targeting the undesired behaviour. School Behavioural management deal with student consequences.
